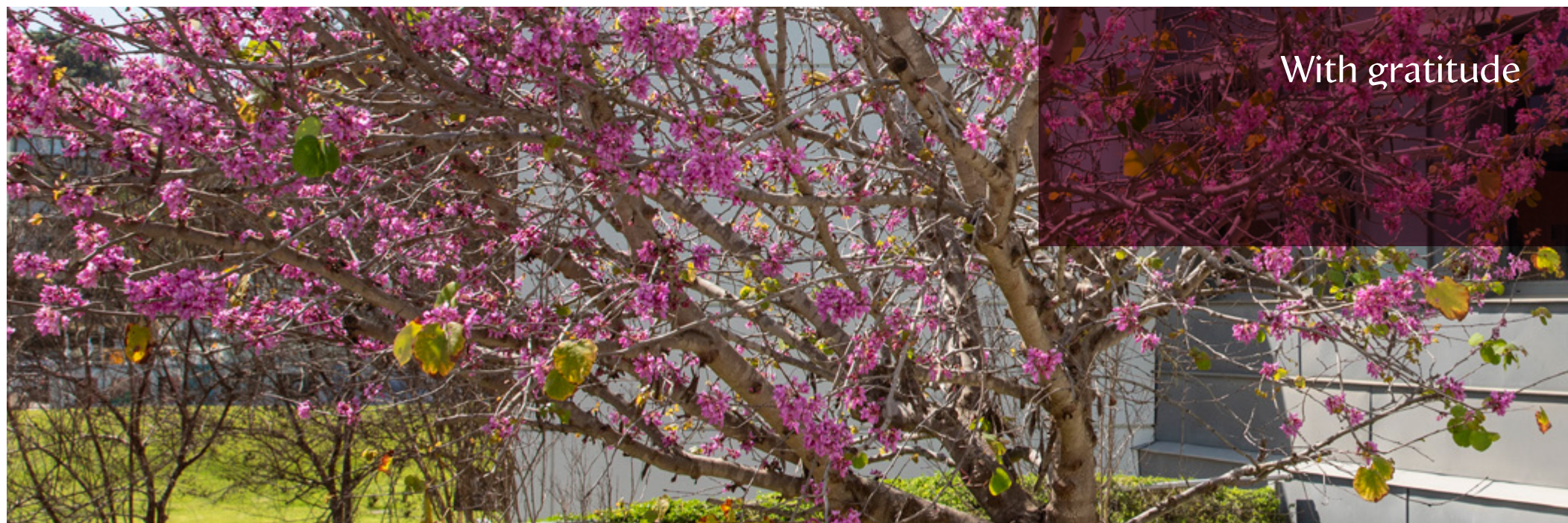


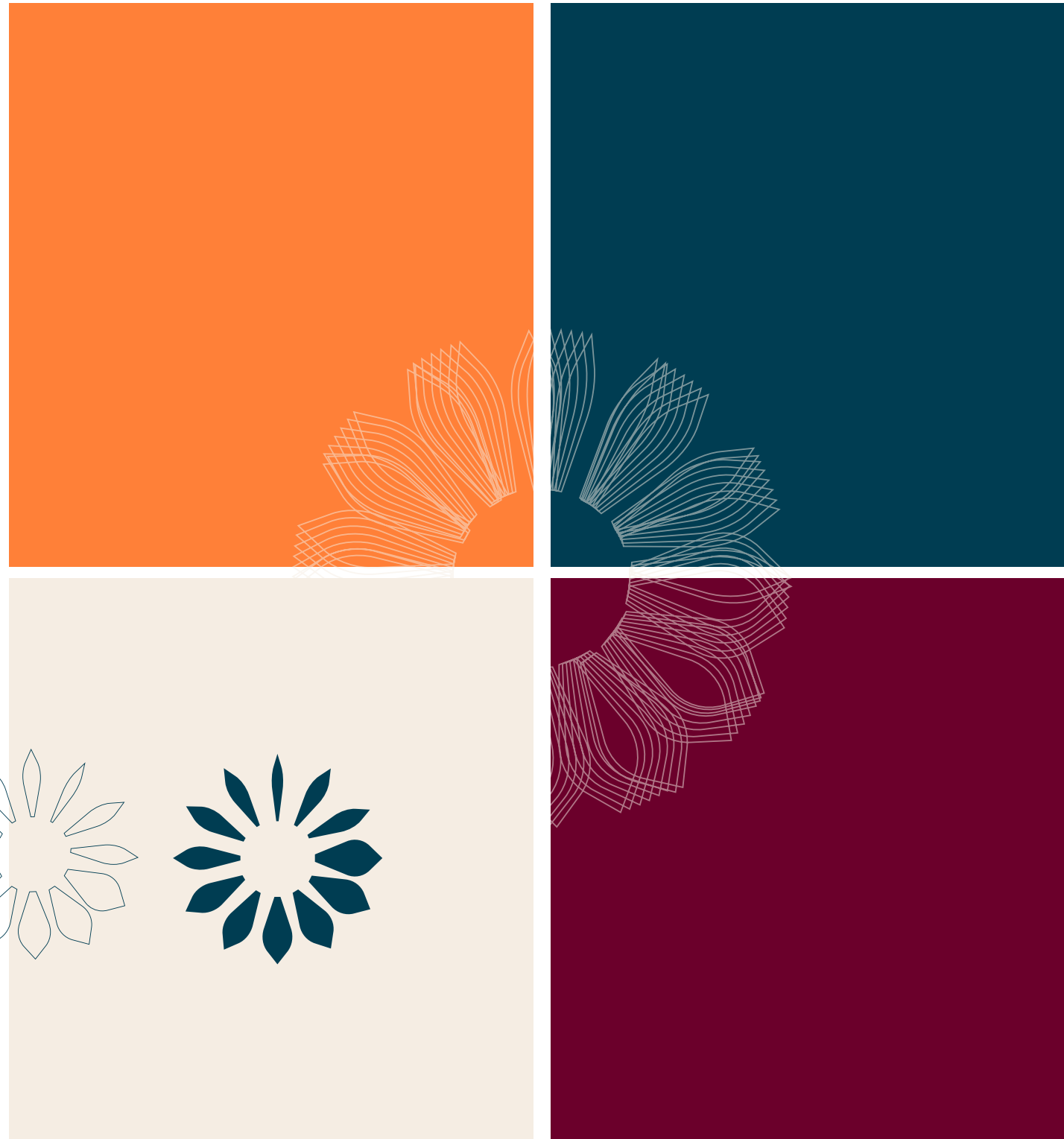

The school is chartered in New York State as the Feinberg Graduate School d/b/a the Weizmann School of Science.

The view from Kfar Aza, one student's story

Translated from MSc student Shira Baum's graduation speech, September 2024

It's an emotional experience for me to stand on this stage here today, nearly three years after I began my journey at the Weizmann Institute of Science, finishing my master's degree while pressing onward toward a PhD.

Each and every one of us should be proud of our achievements. Completing a graduate degree is not a given, particularly after such a tumultuous and difficult year.

I was born and raised on Kibbutz Kfar Aza, a wonderful place with a cohesive and supportive community. That's where I lived until that same Saturday, October 7, when my life—and our lives as a people and as a nation—were changed to the core. I lost many of my neighbors and friends that day, and five members of our kibbutz are still being held hostage in Gaza. That same Saturday morning, I was with my parents at our home on the kibbutz when the terrorists invaded. They violently broke into our home, leaving destruction in their wake, but were unable to breach our safe room thanks to my father's resourcefulness and heroism. After some 30 hours locked in the safe room, the military reached our house and extricated us.

These events shook me and sent me into a spiral of confusion, giving rise to difficult questions. How do we move on when everything feels meaningless? How do we keep on living and functioning day after day when so many people, friends and neighbors I grew up with, will never come back? When there's no house to go back to, and the community I was part of will never be the same?

My work and research in my lab this past year meant choosing life and served as a goal for me to grab on to. My research was a way to find some order and logic in this insane and chaotic reality—a first step that gave me a speck of light in all this darkness.

This last year has taught me the importance of community and the people who comprise it, and of finding a supportive environment that helps you grow stronger and handle

crises. Here at the Weizmann Institute, I feel that I've had the privilege of working and studying among just such a community. The fact that I'm standing here today, that I successfully completed my master's degree during a year like this, is testament to the outpouring of support I received from so many people—from the head of my lab, Prof. Ronen Alon, who gave me much-needed space and support; from my lab associates, who helped me when I needed it; and from the department secretary and the graduate school secretary, who patiently answered all of my questions.

Immunology, my field of research, deals with understanding the body's response to diseases and crises, and finding solutions and medications in the hope that one day, our work will save lives. It is a field dedicated to healing.

My wish for us is that the struggles we are now going through will lead to healing, that we will grow and improve both as individuals and as a community, that we will get better, smile again, be joyful again, and that we will choose life.

Although this is a graduation ceremony, I feel that for me, it's just the beginning. I'll be continuing at the Weizmann Institute, among a community that gives me strength, allows me to study and perform research at the highest level, and to feel alive and move forward, step by step, toward healing.

Esteemed graduates, I'd like to wish us all success in this new chapter of our lives. I hope we will know how to choose well, and that the values we have learned here at the Weizmann Institute will stay with us as we continue our journey.

I wish us all better and quieter times and pray for the safe return of all our hostages.

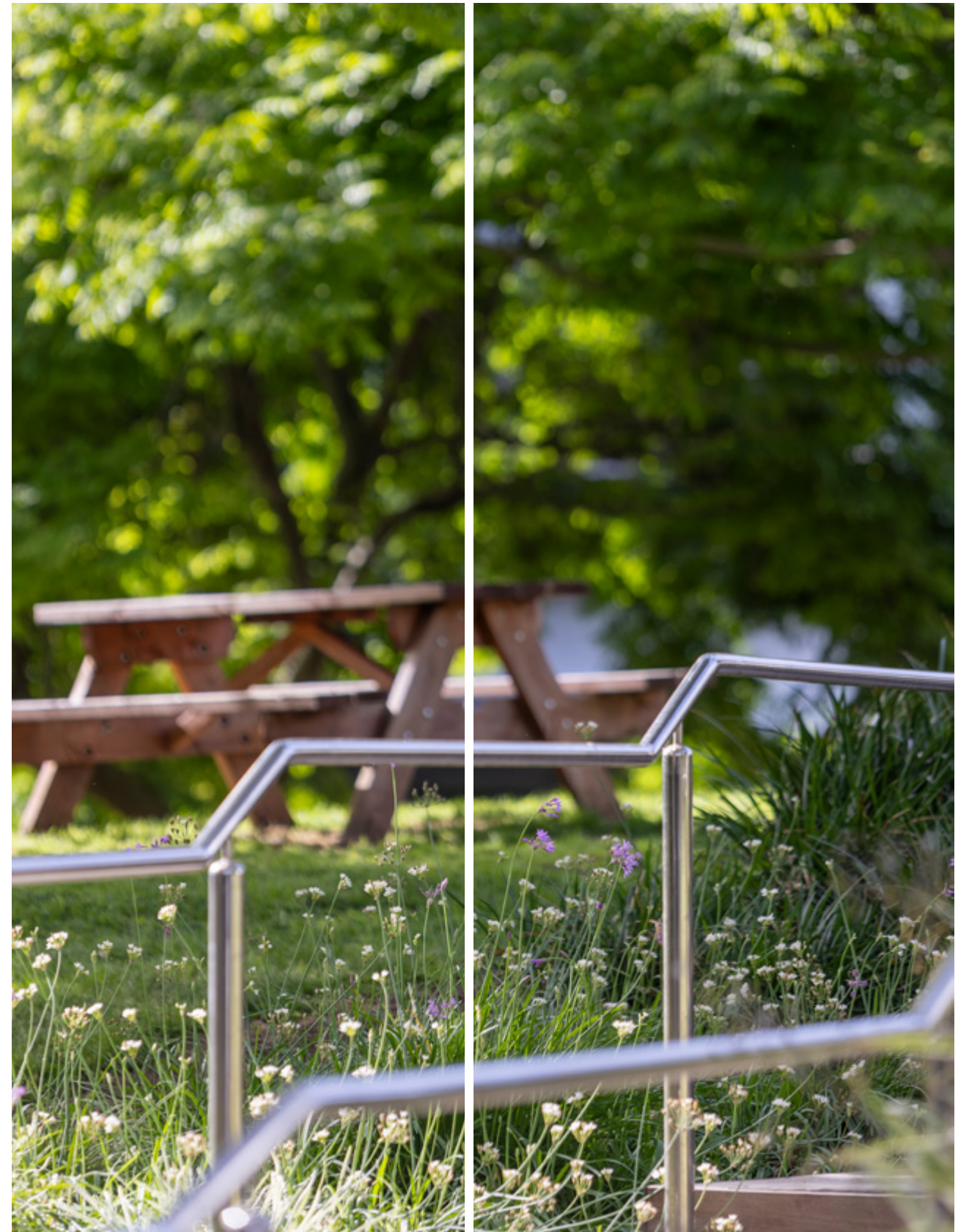

The Gad Resheff Memorial Prize

A doctoral student in the Department of Biophysics, Gad Resheff was killed while serving as the commander of a Suez Canal outpost during the 1973 Yom Kippur War. He was posthumously awarded the Medal of Valor.

RESEARCH FOCUS: I'm studying immunology and cancer, focusing on finding better ways to treat cancer using immunotherapy, which helps the body's immune system fight cancer. Specifically, we focus on T-cells, a type of immune cell that plays a key role. We developed a method to track these cells in real-time to see how they behave as they interact with tumors. I also contributed to new cancer treatments, including antibody and cell-based treatments, aimed at overcoming some of the toughest challenges in cancer therapy today.
